FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What exactly is Carlton Landing?

Oklahoma's newest town, with our own mayor, board of trustees, and the right to vote. As a town, our property taxes can be utilized to invest in public amenities that benefit the community. Amenities like the Nature Trails and Town Swim Beach are both the result of a vote chosen by the members of this town.

How many homes are there in Carlton Landing and how many for the future?

As of 2019, there are 240 houses in Carlton Landing and the long-term master plan covers an area of 3000 acres, 2500-3000 homes, following a 30-40 year plan to complete.

What is the population of Carlton Landing?

Approximately 24 families currently call Carlton Landing their full-time home. The other 200 families make up second homeowners, some visit every week, others seasonally, and many choose to take advantage of the Vacation Rental Program.

How much work is it to own a lake home here?

You can make it as hands off as you would like. We have some great local service providers that offer

weekly walkthrough inspections, general repair, house cleaning and laundry, and pretty much anything else that comes with lake living.

Can I purchase a home and rent it out?

Absolutely! Many families purchase a home and rent it out when they're not using it through the Carlton Landing Vacation Rental Program to help offset expenses of home ownership. To learn more about this program, contact the Hospitality Team at 918-452-2205.

What are the boating options at Carlton Landing?

The Carlton Landing Boat Club is the easiest way to enjoy the lake, giving you have access to an entire fleet of pontoon and ski boats. It's as simple as getting online to make a reservation and arriving to a full tank of fuel and fully equipped boat with life jackets, tubes, skis and all that you need to make your time on the lake hassle free. No cleaning, no maintenance, no worries. There is also a 60 slip marina where you may rent a boat slip and store your personal boat, with plans to expand to 300 for a full service marina.



How much is the tuition for the Carlton Landing Academy?

As the first rural public chart school, Carlton Landing Academy is tuition-free offering an exemplary learning environment to for students K-8.

The Residence Club FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS THE RESIDENCE CLUB AT CARLTON LANDING?

The Residence Club at Carlton Landing is an equity residence club[™] providing owners with shared ownership of charming, fully furnished lakeside residences within the Carlton Landing resort community. Owners lodge in meticulously appointed residences and have Boat Club privileges. The Club staff ensures worry-free ownership and hassle-free vacations.

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF RESIDENCE CLUB OWNERSHIP?

Residence clubs combine the benefits of vacation home ownership with resort amenities and hotel services. Residence club ownership provides generous and flexible vacation use, removes the worries typically associated with absentee ownership, and significantly reduces the financial burden. The Residence Club at Carlton Landing provides the added benefit of lifetime Boat Club privileges.

DO CLUB OWNERS OWN REAL ESTATE?

Yes. Ownership is evidenced by a real estate deed, which is recorded and guaranteed by a title insurance policy. Each owner is conveyed a oneseventh, debt-free, undivided deeded interest in one of the Club's fully furnished residences.

AS AN OWNER, HOW OFTEN CAN I VACATION AT MY CLUB?

As often as you wish, subject only to the Club's reservations policies and availability. Owners have the flexibility of reserving Planned Vacations well in advance and also visiting on a short-notice basis. Each year, owners may reserve 21 days of Planned Vacations in advance. This leaves abundant additional occupancy for space available vacations during the year. If all owners use their club equally throughout the year, each would enjoy a minimum of seven weeks annually. However, there is no limit on use. If some owners visit their Club less, others can visit more.

IS THE RESIDENCE CLUB AT CARLTON LANDING A TIMESHARE?

No. Timeshare is typically the right to use only a specific week or weeks and lodging is limited to a specific residence. Residence Club owners have access to all Club residences within their ownership category (Park Street, Lakeview, and Veranda), with the right to unlimited use during all seasons, subject only to the reservation policies and availability.

DO OWNERS PAY ANNUAL FEES?

Yes. The comprehensive annual fees pay for the professional management and operation of the Club accommodations and pro rata share of the costs associated with the Boat Club. Included in these annual fees are funds for staff salaries, housekeeping, supplies, maintenance, trash removal, legal/accounting, utilities, transportation, management fee, boat maintenance, reserves scheduled replacement of Club residence furnishings and appliances. These fees are a fraction of the costs associated with traditional ownership of a vacation home and boat.

DO OWNERS PAY ANY LODGING OR HOUSEKEEPING FEES WHEN THEY VACATION AT THEIR CLUB?

Owners pay only a post-occupancy cleaning fee. An optional daily tidy service is available upon request for a fee.

Each contract expires on October 31 of each year. Renewal begins Nov I. Any break in the renewal process may lead to a new initiation fee requirement.

No problem! We require and provide all boaters, experienced and inexperienced, boat safety training, including instruction on the water. We will gladly stay with you until you are comfortable operating the various boats of the fleet (one boat is not equal to another).

WHAT TYPE OF INSURANCE IS PROVIDED

OR DO MEMBERS PROVIDE THEIR OWN COVERAGE?

As a club member, you are covered under the club's insurance policy.

ARE THERE ANY HIDDEN EXPENSES? Members are responsible for dues fuel and al

Members are responsible for dues, fuel, and all damage repairs to boats and/or equipment.

MAY WE VISIT THE OPERATION AND SEE THE BOATS?

IS THERE A LIMIT ON THE NUMBER OF TIMES PER YEAR YOU CAN BOAT?

No, we encourage you to get out on the water as often as your schedule allows.

WHO CAN I BRING WITH ME ON A BOAT? Anybody, as long as a member is on board.

Also, as a member of the Boat Club, we provide all the water toys – complimentary wakeboards, kneeboards, tubes, skis and life-jackets. You just show up to share priceless memories with your family and friends, and our staff will handle the rest.

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES TO BOAT CLUB MEMBERSHIP COMPARED TO OWNING A BOAT DIRECTLY?

YOU MONEY. Owning a boat is an expensive
proposition! First, consider the cost to purchase a

But then the next day, you hear that the sand bass are schooling and it's time to grab your rig and hit the lake. So you reserve a Harris 220 FloteBote with the upgraded fishing package. You've got the GPS, depthfinder and livewell just waiting for you.

#3 – Membership in the Boat Club means YOU HAVE MORE TIME and LESS HASSLE.

The best part of membership in the Boat Club is the ease of use. Our professional staff stands ready to take care of your needs. They handle the boat maintenance, seasonal care of the equipment, and will always present you with a clean boat in good condition with a charged battery, a straight prop and a stocked ice chest.

WHAT ARE THE DIFFERENCES IN THE MEMBERSHIP LEVELS?

Admiral – This premier level of membership is available exclusively to individuals who own real property or manage vacation rental property in Carlton Landing. This membership can then be used by rental guests during their stay in Carlton Landing subject to the terms of an Individual Membership. Member has access to all Admiral Fleet boats and is guaranteed one reservation per day subject to the requisite 72 hour notice.

Commodore – This next tier member has access to all main fleet boats and may schedule reservations up to one hundred eighty (180) days in advance. Commodores may have up to twelve (12) reservations in the system at any given time. An unlimited amount of reservations may be made within fifteen (15) days of the reservation date.

Captain – This second tier member has access to all main fleet boats and may schedule reservations up to one hundred twenty (120) days in advance. Captains may have up to nine (9) reservations in the system at any given time. An unlimited amount of reservations may be made within fifteen (15) days of the reservation date.

Commander – For those who enjoy the lake best away from the holiday crowds, this membership is for you. Commanders have access to all main fleet boats and may schedule reservations up to thirty (75) days in advance. Commanders may schedule up to six (6) reservations at a time. An unlimited amount of reservations may be made within fifteen (15) days of the reservation date.

WHAT TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE?

Individual Membership –Persons with an Individual Membership, as evidenced by the execution of this Agreement, are entitled to all the rights and privileges of the Boat Club subject to all reasonable rules and regulations and terms of this Agreement.

Family Membership – Persons who are in the immediate family of an Individual Member, that is, spouses and children [between the ages of twentyone (21) and twenty-five (25)] shall be entitled to the rights and privileges of that membership subject to all reasonable rules and regulations and this Agreement. Under the Family Membership, access and reservations for the Boats may be granted to any qualified family member who is also qualified to operate a Boat under this Agreement.

Household Membership – Persons who are owners of record of real property within Carlton Landing



may join as a Household Membership. In such event, up to five (5) signers who are owners of that household or immediate family that are in residence on the reservation date (adult child, brother, sister, mother, father, aunt, uncle, and/or first cousins) shall be entitled to the rights and privileges of membership subject to all reasonable rules and regulations and this Agreement. Owners of separate households within Carlton Landing or owners of a single household outside of Carlton Landing do no qualify for the Household Membership.

HOW DO I RESERVE A BOAT?

Reservations are scheduled using our online reservation system available through the login on the Boat Club home page. Members are given a username and password. Reservations are revolving. As soon as you use or cancel one reservation, you have the opportunit to create a new reservation. In addition, you are not limited to the amount of times you may use a boat.

WHAT IF I WANT TO MAKE A RESERVATION WITH LESS THAN 48 HOURS' NOTICE?

48 hours' notice is required for online reservations However, if you would like to reserve a boat with less than 48 hours' notice, please visit the boat dock and speak with a member of the Boat Club Staff.

CONSIDERING RENTING YOUR HOME AS PART OF HOME OWNERSHIP?

Carlton Landing is about getting the most out of the outdoors, beautiful natural surroundings, and all the comforts of home, making vacationing here a great and appealing option for families. Many homeowners choose to make use of our turnkey Vacation Rental Program to use when their home is not occupied. At the end of 2019, the rental program had 40 active units.





Homes in the Rental Program

There are many options when it comes to styles of homes here in town. Every home is unique in Carlton Landing, which gives our guests a wide variety to choose from. To accommodate a sometimes very specific list of needs from our guests, we have everything available from a studio garage apartment to a large five bedroom house. You are welcome to scroll through the homes on our website to view the lovely variations. Because each home is owned by individual owners, you will see a plethora of styles and décor.

Let's review the advantages or profit of the home rental program. Here are some average income totals over the last year 2019: (This is the number actually paid to the owner). Also included is the average nightly rate for similar sized homes.

Both the size of the home and the sleep capacity determine the nightly rate. Because each home is so unique, it is rather difficult to group them in to specific categories.



Joining the Home Rental Program

It's also helpful to know what it costs to enter the program. Depending on the size of the home and the bed choices made, the cost to furnish can vary greatly. The major cost, besides all the furnishings, will be your linen purchase. Again, this is dependent on the size and number of beds you choose, but averages between \$1500 and \$2800. After all furnishings are in and linens are stocked, we schedule photography and that cost averages \$150 to \$250. Monthly fees include a \$30 technology charge, which helps us offset the cost of our reservation system. Housekeeping charges are set based on the size of the home. Owners are required to pay the fee after each time they or any guests of theirs stays in their home. We provide a hands-free maintenance program that includes quarterly pest control (\$90 each service) and a quarterly maintenance of changing lock batteries and air filters (roughly \$50 each service).

Our peak season begins in May and technically ends with Labor Day. With that said, we have been very pleased with a busier Fall season in recent years. Please keep in mind that the number of days an owner uses their home during this time will have a major impact on their income. We've had one home owner that acquired enough income to cover their expenses entirely.
